The 2017 General Appropriations Act (GAA) Special Provisions for the PAyapa at MAsaganangPamayaNAn (PAMANA) program requires OPAPP to "submit to the Office of the President, the DBM, the Speaker of the House of the Representatives, the President of the Senate of the Philippines, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, validated quarterly reports on the status of the utilization of funds by implementing agencies, and evaluation reports. The Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said reports are likewise posted on the OPAPP website."

Furthermore, in relation to the implementation of the PAMANA Projects whose funds are lodged with OPAPP, OPAPP is required to "submit to the Office of the President, the DBM, the Speaker of the House of the Representatives, the President of the Senate of the Philippines, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on the status of the implementation of the PAMANA program. The Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the OPAPP website."

In compliance to the aforementioned requirements, we are pleased to submit herewith the OPAPP's Third Quarter Accomplishment Report FY 2017, including status of PAMANA projects whose funds are lodged with OPAPP.

Also attached herewith is the Physical Report of Operations, which is a translation of the OPAPP Third Quarter Accomplishment Report into the template matrix required by the DBM.
