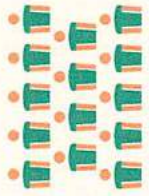

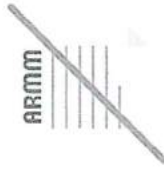


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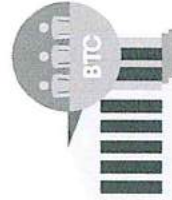
Plebiscite for the BOL

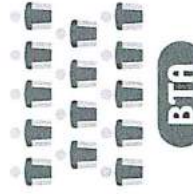

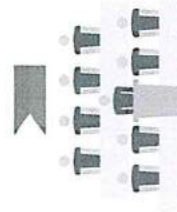

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SECURITY

TRANSITIONAL COMPONENTS OF NORMALIZATION

The GPH and the MILF will work together to secure peace on the ground during transition period through different mechanisms.



The **Joint Normalization Committee (JNC)** shall coordinate the different processes in normalization and develop a program for the reduction and management of small arms and light weapons (SALWs) of individuals and groups.

The **Joint Peace and Security Committee (JPSC)** shall have the following functions:

- a. Coordinate with the two Parties' command structures on security arrangements relevant to its functions;
- b. Develop policies and operational guidelines for the effective partnership of the JPSTs; and
- c. Coordinate the security arrangements for the activities related to the implementation of the FAB and its Annexes.



The **Joint Peace and Security Teams (JPSTs)** shall be the operating units composed of contingents of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), the PNP, and the MILF's Bangsamoro Islamic Armed Forces (BIAF). These mechanisms shall work for the maintenance of peace and order and the stability of the areas mutually identified by the GPH and the MILF.



DECOMMISSIONING

The MILF shall undertake a graduated program for decommissioning of its forces so that these are put beyond use.

Decommissioning shall be a process that includes activities aimed at achieving a smooth transition for the Bangsamoro Islamic Armed Forces (BIAF) members to productive civilian life.

A comprehensive needs assessment shall be undertaken for the members of the BIAF and their communities as a basis for a comprehensive socio-economic development program.



The **Independent Decommissioning Body (IDB)** will oversee the process of decommissioning of MILF forces and weapons.

POLICING

Law enforcement and maintenance of peace and order in the Bangsamoro shall be the primary function of the police force for the Bangsamoro.

The police force for the Bangsamoro shall be professional, civilian in character, effective and efficient in law enforcement, fair and impartial, and accountable under the law for its actions. It shall be responsible both to the Central Government and the Bangsamoro Government, and to the communities it serves.



In April 2014, the **Independent Commission on Policing (ICP)** submitted to the GPH and MILF Panels its recommendations on the appropriate policing for the Bangsamoro.

REDEPLOYMENT OF THE AFP

The government shall redeploy AFP units and troops from or within the Bangsamoro consistent with the progress in the security aspects of normalization.

There will be an orderly redeployment of AFP units and troops to avoid a security vacuum in the Bangsamoro.

The AFP shall only retain installations necessary for national defense and security.



UXOS AND LANDMINES

Both Parties commit to jointly undertake mines/unexploded ordnance (UXO) detection and clearance (demining) as well as mine risk education.



DISBANDING PRIVATE ARMED GROUPS (PAGS)

The GPH, in coordination with the MILF, will conduct a corresponding assessment and devise a plan for the disbandment of private armed groups in the Bangsamoro.



ANNEX ON NORMALIZATION

OF THE COMPREHENSIVE AGREEMENT ON THE BANGSAMORO (signed on 25 January 2014)

Normalization is a process whereby communities can achieve their desired quality of life, which includes the pursuit of sustainable livelihood and political participation within a peaceful deliberative society. It aims to ensure human security in the Bangsamoro.

Normalization will simultaneously happen alongside the roadmap towards the creation of the Bangsamoro (see *Phases at the back*).

The normalization process has four main components: (1) security aspect; (2) socio-economic development; (3) transitional justice; and (4) confidence-building measures.



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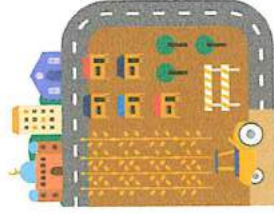
TRANSITIONAL JUSTICE AND RECONCILIATION



A **Transitional Justice and Reconciliation Commission (TJRC)** is tasked to undertake a study and recommend to the Panels the appropriate mechanisms to address the legitimate grievances of the Bangsamoro people, correct historical injustices, and address human rights violations.

In February 2016, the TJRC officially submitted its report to the Panels, with supplementary reports handed over in February 2017.

SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM



Both Parties agree to intensify development efforts for the rehabilitation, reconstruction, and development of the Bangsamoro, and institute programs to address the needs of BIAF members, internally displaced persons (IDPs), and poverty-stricken communities.

The socio-economic programs shall be community-based and must reinforce social cohesion. These programs should also strengthen and preserve the unity of the communities.

The **Task Force for Decommissioned Combatants and their Communities (TFDCC)** is mandated to undertake efforts related to socio-economic and development programs for MILF combatants and their communities, aimed at helping them transition to productive civilian life.

CONFIDENCE-BUILDING MEASURES



AMNESTY

Government shall take immediate steps through amnesty, pardon, and other available processes towards the resolution of cases of persons charged with or convicted of crimes and offenses connected to the armed conflict in Mindanao.



TRANSFORMATION OF CAMPS

The **Joint Task Forces on Camps Transformation (JTFACT)** are tasked to assess the needs, plan appropriate programs, and undertake the necessary measures to transform previously acknowledged MILF camps into peaceful and productive communities.

PHASES OF PROGRAM FOR NORMALIZATION IN THE BANGSAMORO

The phasing and sequencing of the different elements of the Annex on Normalization is in a matrix that was released upon the signing of the Comprehensive Agreement on the Bangsamoro (CAB). It shows that the Program for Normalization in the Bangsamoro is aligned with the political component of the implementation of the CAB.



PHASE 1

From the signing of the Annex on Normalization up to the completion of the verification and validation conducted by the Independent Decommissioning Body.



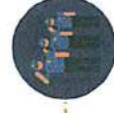
PHASE 2

Completion of validation of MILF forces up to the ratification of the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL).



PHASE 3

From the ratification of the Bangsamoro Organic Law up to the establishment and operationalization of the police force for the Bangsamoro.



PHASE 4

From the operationalization of the police force for the Bangsamoro up to 2 months prior to the signing of the Exit Agreement provided that the evaluation of the Panels with the participation of the Third Party Monitoring Team and Facilitator that all the commitment of the parties, except the remaining stage of decommissioning, has been completed.

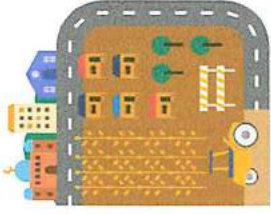

TRANSITIONAL COMPONENTS OF NORMALIZATION

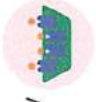
In GPH iban sin MILF mag sama sama himinang ha pagjaga atawa pagjaga sin kasanyangan ha babaan ha waktu sin transition period ha ran sin paghinang sin ginisan kakahinang ha supaya matunay in pag-yanun kasanyangan.



In **Joint Normalization Committe (JNC)** magpahati sin ginisan hinangun ha parkala pagpahantap iban magpikli programa ha pag-pababah iban ha pag-manage atawa ha pag-intul sin mga tau atawa tumpukan maghinhang titimbakan sibi-sibi iban titimbakan magaan.

In hinang sin **Joint Peace and Security Committee (JPSC)** amuna in:

In **Joint and Peace Security teams (JPSTs)** sila ini in operating units amuin magpaparagan lamud na in kaibanan daing ha Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) amuin pagbahasahun Kaput Balis sin parinta, PNP, iban sin MILF Bangsamoro Islamic Armed Forces (BIAF Kaput Balis sin MILF). In hinang nila ini mag patattap sin kahanungan iban katutug sin manga lugal kiyapag-isunan sin PGH iban sin MILF.

PAGPINDA

In **Independent Decommissioning Body (IDB)** jumaga ha parkala sin pagpinda sin mga sundalu MILF lamud na in mga sanjata nila.



PAGPARAGAN SIN PAGPULIS HA HULA

In pagbantang sin sara iban pagpatattap sin kahanungan ha hulah sin Bangsamoro amuna in panagnaan hinang sin Bangsamoro police.

In police sin Bangsamoro subay professional, civilian in hantang, maingat iban mabuntul magda sin sarah, adli iban dih mag-pii, iban manjari tuntutan bang makalanggal sarah. Kiyawajib sin sila ini pa sibuh da pa Parinta ha kataasan iban pa Bangsamoro iban na pa kawman bang haunu sila na-assigned atawa nagajaga.

Ha bulan April tahun 2014, in **Independent Commission on Policing (ICP)** dimihl pa GPH iban MILF Panels, sin mga pikilan nila ha kahalan sin hi katup sin hihinangun pagpulis atawa pagjaga sin mga pulis.



PAGBUTANG SIN MANGA AFP

Maaun in pag-ayad sin pagbutang ha manga sundalu sin AFP ha supaya way kapiligruhan jumatu atawa di kapasaran in pagjaga ha Bangsamoro.

In pagpatutug sin AFP ha hula sin bangsamoro bang kagunahan ha national defense iban security.



UXOS AND LANDMINES

In duwa tumpukan atawa parties magagad ha paghidjatul sin mines/unexploded ordinance (UXO) detection iban clearance (pag-ig sin mga landmine) iban mang dihlil panghati ha tungud sin kapiligruhan sin landmine amuin pagtawagun mine risk education.

PAG-IG SIN MGA PRIVATE ARMED GROUPS (TUMPUKAN NAGDARA SINAPANG)

In GPH, labay ha pagisun iban sin MILF, mag pikilan iban humati iban magpawon plano hasupaya malarak atawa maig na in pagtawagun private armed groups ha hula sin manga Bangsamoro.

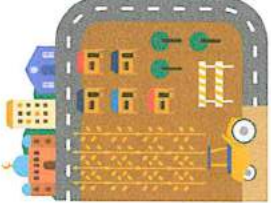

OF THE COMPREHENSIVE AGREEMENT ON THE BANGSAMORO (signed on 25 January 2014)

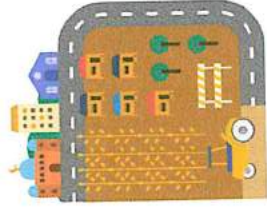

IKAPAT A UKIT

Iganat kanu kanggulialan sa kallintad sa Bangsamoro taman kanu duwa ulan na kinapirma kanu taman nu pinagayunan asal na su sipat nu mimbitiyala (Panels) endo apeg nu taga liyo na pedtanding sa kanu mga napasadan na nakanggulialan, apiya adenpan mga paiddo na masama pembalingan.

The Bangsamoro Government: Parliamentary System


The powers of government shall be vested in the Parliament.

THE BANGSAMORO PARLIAMENT
It shall be composed of at least eighty (80) members and shall have the authority to enact laws on matters within the powers of the Bangsamoro Government. It shall have a Speaker and a Deputy Speaker.




REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE BANGSAMORO SHALL VOTE FOR:

- Political parties (seats allocated through proportional representation)
- Parliamentary district representatives elected through direct plurality and
- Representatives for reserved and sectoral seats



RESERVED AND SECTORAL SEATS

- Two (2) seats each for non-Moro indigenous peoples and settler communities
- One (1) sectoral seat each for women, youth, traditional leaders, and the *ulama*
- Manner of election for sectoral seats will be determined by the Parliament
- Reserved seats for non-Moro indigenous communities shall be pursuant to their customary laws and indigenous practices



COUNCIL OF LEADERS
It advises the Chief Minister in governing the Bangsamoro. It is composed of the Chief Minister, provincial governors, mayors of chartered cities, members of Congress of the Philippines from the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region (BAR) indigenous peoples, women, settler communities, *ulama*, youth, Bangsamoro communities outside of the Bangsamoro territory, and other sectors.



PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES

The President shall exercise general supervision over the Bangsamoro Government to ensure that laws are faithfully executed.



CHIEF MINISTER

- Heads the Bangsamoro Government
- Shall be elected by a majority vote of all members of the parliament

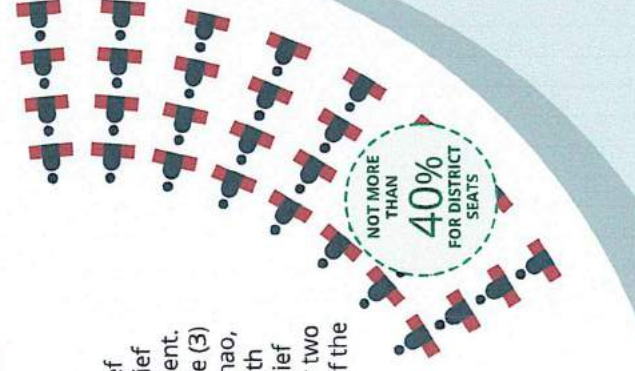


CABINET

The executive function and authority shall be exercised by the Cabinet, headed by the Chief Minister who shall nominate two (2) Deputy Chief Ministers and appoint members of the Cabinet, majority of whom shall also come from the Parliament.

TWO (2) DEPUTY CHIEF MINISTERS

There will be two (2) Deputy Chief Ministers as nominated by the Chief Minister and elected by the Parliament. To ensure representation from three (3) sub-regions (South Western Mindanao, North Central Mindanao, and South Central Mindanao), the Deputy Chief Ministers shall come from the other two (2) sub-regions different from that of the Chief Minister.



WALI

- Ceremonial head of the Bangsamoro Gov't
- Shall only take on ceremonial functions
- Chosen by the Bangsamoro Parliament
- Will have a term of 6 years; first Wali, to be appointed by BTA, has 3 years
- Shall administer the oath of office of all Parliament members including the Chief Minister
- Shall dissolve the Parliament upon advise of the Chief Minister after a vote no confidence against the government of the day



IS A PARLIAMENTARY FORM OF GOVERNMENT ALLOWED UNDER THE 1987 CONSTITUTION?



A parliamentary form of government in the Bangsamoro is possible under the 1987 Constitution.

The Constitution does not prescribe a particular form of democratic government for the autonomous regions. It only provides that

THE ORGANIC ACT SHALL DEFINE THE BASIC STRUCTURE OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE REGION CONSISTING OF THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT AND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, BOTH OF WHICH SHALL BE ELECTIVE AND REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CONSTITUENT POLITICAL UNITS. x x x ”

See Art. X, Sec. 18 of the 1987 Constitution.

A parliamentary form of government satisfies these conditions. The legislative authority is vested in the Bangsamoro Parliament composed of party representatives, district representatives, and reserved seats and

sectoral representatives, to be chosen by the registered voters in the Bangsamoro. The Chief Minister, who heads the Bangsamoro Government, shall be elected by a majority vote of the Bangsamoro Parliament from among its members. The Chief Minister is thus an elected official.

The parliamentary form of government allows more democratic participation, ensures greater diversity and representation, and encourages the formation of genuinely principled political parties.

The BOL states that

A FREE AND OPEN REGIONAL PARTY SYSTEM SHALL BE ALLOWED TO EVOLVE ACCORDING TO THE FREE CHOICE OF THE PEOPLE.”

See Art. VII, Sec. 9 of Republic Act No. 11054

Residents of the Bangsamoro will have an opportunity to form parties, participate in the elections and win seats in the Bangsamoro Parliament, and be involved in governance.
