INVITATION TO BID FOR SECURITY SERVICES

1. The Office of the Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process (OPAPP), through the GAA for FY2021, intends to apply the sum of Six Million Six Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Pesos and 48/100 (PhP6,651,930.48), being the ABC to payments under the contract for Security Services for the OPAPP in Ortigas, Pasig City and Brgy. Awang, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao, for May 2021 to December 2021. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The OPAPP now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required by 1 May 2021. Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “*pass/fail*” criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from OPAPP and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during from 8am to 5pm.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on 12 March 2021 to 20 March 2021, from the given address and website(s) below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the the GPPB Resolution 4 – 2012, dated 24 February 2012, in the amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (PhP10,000.00). The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees either in person, by facsimile, or through any electronic means.
6. The OPAPP will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on 22 March 2021, Monday, 10am, at at Kapayapaan Conference Room, 7th Floor Agustin I Bldg., F.Ortigas Jr. Road, Ortigas Center, Pasig City, and/or through video conferencing or Zoom applications (the

access ID may be secured from the BAC Secretariat), which shall be open to prospective bidders.

7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below, on or before 5 April 2021, Monday, 10am. Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
9. Bid opening shall be on 5 April 2021, Monday, 1pm, at the given address below and via Zoom applications. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
10. The reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
