INVITATION TO BID FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF PRIMARY AND SECONDARY INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDER (ISP) FOR OPAPRU CENTRAL OFFICE FOR THE PERIOD OF 01 JANUARY 2024 TO 31 DECEMBER 2024

- 1. The Office of the Presidential Adviser on Peace Reconciliation and Unity (OPAPRU), intends to apply the sum of **Two Million Eight Hundred Nineteen Thousand Three Hundred Four Pesos Only (PHP2,819,304.00)** being the ABC to payments under the contract for the **Procurement of Primary and Secondary Internet Service Provider (ISP) for OPAPRU Central Office for the period of 01 January 2024 to 31 December 2024.** Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 2. The OPAPRU encourages the submission of bids for the Procurement Project. The Delivery Date of the Goods shall be made on the date indicated in the Notice to Proceed. Interested bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Procurement Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders) thereof.
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
 - Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from OPAPRU and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during weekdays (Monday Friday) from 08:00 AM to 05:00 PM.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on 9 October 2023 to 7 November 2023 from the given address and website(s) below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos Only (PHP5,000.00). The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees either in person, by facsimile, or through electronic means.
- 6. The OPAPRU will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on 17 October 2023 at the BAC Conference Room, 3rd Floor Agustin I Bldg., F. Ortigas Jr. Road, Ortigas Center, Pasig City, and/or through video conferencing or webcasting, which shall be open to prospective bidders.

- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below **on or before 7 November 2023, (10:00AM). Late bids shall not be accepted.**
- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on 7 November 2023, (10:30AM) at the given address below. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder/s representative/s who choose to attend the activity.
- 10. The OPAPRU reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to the award of the contract in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
